

Finding help for opioid use disorder and/or substance use disorder

Every **15 minutes** in the United States, a baby is born with opioid withdrawal. According to a 2018 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention study, the number of pregnant women diagnosed with opioid use disorder (OUD) during labor and birth in the U.S. **increased more than four times from 1999 to 2014**. In Kentucky, the number climbed from 0.4 per 1,000 delivery hospitalizations in 2000 to 19.3 in 2014.¹

If you have a problem, get help early. It can improve your and your baby's chances for a better outcome.

The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists recommends:

- Getting help for substance use as early as you can in your pregnancy
- Going to all your prenatal and postpartum doctor visits to make sure you have a healthy pregnancy and baby

The StrongWell team works with pregnant women to help:

- Stabilize Steady all aspects of their lives
- Support their goals for themselves and their babies

Through StrongWell, you get care and support during and after pregnancy (up to one year), like:

- 24/7 mobile app, phone and text support
- A care team, including a licensed counselor, nurse educator, and a peer specialist
- A plan made just for you to prevent relapse and steady your life
- Help through the recovery process
- Convenient care that meets you where you are
- Help finding local support like food, clothing, housing and transportation
- Counseling to help you meet your goals
- Education from a nurse to have a healthy pregnancy and birth
- Support from peer specialists who have also been through recovery

Our pregnant enrollees also get access to programs that can help you:

- Connect with an online group of women who have been where you are
- Get one-on-one and group counseling and peer support
- Have a healthy pregnancy and birth
- Keep your family intact
- Work through the challenges of substance use during pregnancy
