Prescriber FAQ on generic Breo Ellipta

- 1. Q: Is generic Breo Ellipta (fluticasone furoate/vilanterol) being covered at the pharmacy?
 - **A:** For Humana's commercial formularies, Medicare Advantage prescription drug plans and Medicare Part D plans, brand-name Breo Ellipta is covered and can be filled for your patients. Generic Breo Ellipta (fluticasone furoate/vilanterol) is not covered.
- 2. Q: Why isn't fluticasone furoate/vilanterol covered?
 - **A:** Humana decided not to cover fluticasone furoate/vilanterol at this time; brand-name Breo Ellipta is on the formulary.
- 3. Q: Can I request an exception for fluticasone furoate/vilanterol?
 - **A:** Yes, but the cost share for fluticasone furoate/vilanterol may be the same as or higher than brand-name Breo Ellipta.
- 4. Q: Will fluticasone furoate/vilanterol be covered in the future?
 - **A:** Humana may cover fluticasone furoate/vilanterol at some point in the future.
