

Information about the launch of generic Durezol

Effective Oct. 1, 2021, generic Durezol (difluprednate) is not covered for CarePlus patients. Brand-name Durezol will continue to be covered and can be filled for the patient.

Prescriber frequently asked questions on generic Durezol

1. Q: Is generic Durezol (difluprednate) being covered at the pharmacy?

A: The generic difluprednate is not covered. For CarePlus plans, brand-name Durezol is covered and can be filled for your patients.

2. Q: Why isn't difluprednate covered?

A: CarePlus decided not to cover difluprednate at this time; brand-name Durezol is on the formulary.

3. Q: Can I request an exception for difluprednate?

A: It is possible, but the cost share for difluprednate may be the same as or higher than brand-name Durezol.

4. Q: Will difluprednate be covered in the future?

A: CarePlus may cover difluprednate at some point in the future.
